**Application for Accelerated Master's Program**

If you are a currently enrolled George Mason University COS undergraduate student, use this internal form in lieu of the standard university *Application for Graduate Study* to initiate the evaluation of your admissibility for an Accelerated Master's Program. If admitted to an Accelerated Master's Program, a specified number of credits (see below) taken while you are in undergraduate status will apply to your undergraduate degree requirements, and you will earn advanced standing into the master's program.

You should set up advising sessions with your undergraduate faculty advisor and with the graduate coordinator of the master's program to review your admissibility for the program and to plan your graduate coursework. The graduate program may require further information before an admissions decision can be rendered. The graduate coordinator should return the signed form to the appropriate Dean's Office responsible for Graduate Programs to request approval. Once signed by the Associate Dean (or Dean's designee), the Dean's Office sends the approved application to the appropriate graduate admissions unit to be processed.
