Additional Examination Information

Exams for classes that meet off-campus locations are held during regularly scheduled meeting days and times.

Instructors announce schedules for lab courses, block courses, and TV courses by mid-semester. **For courses meeting at nonstandard times (those not listed in this exam schedule), instructors are responsible for coordinating an exam time through the Academic Scheduling Office and announcing it to the class by mid semester.**

Students who have more than one examination scheduled at the same time or more than two examinations scheduled on the same day should consult their academic dean to request rescheduling.

Makeup Periods for Final Exams

If the university is unexpectedly closed on an exam day, makeup times will be announced as soon as they are determined. As much as possible, makeup exams will be given at the same time and in the same room as the missed exams. Students and faculty should call the university's main telephone number, 703-993-1000, for information and confirmation of the rescheduling of final exams. This information will also be disseminated throughout the university via other voice and electronic means.

Processing of grades may be delayed by use of makeup days late in the exam period.

Instructor/Course Evaluations

Course Prerequisites

The student is responsible for meeting the prerequisites before attempting to register for a class. If a student has registered for a class without having met the prerequisites, the department may request, during the first week of class, that he/she drop the course.
